

- (b) The time limit for part-time student is:
- i. a minimum of 24 months
 - ii. a maximum of 36 months.

9. Honours, Distinction and Merit

10 Pathways to other qualifications

- (a) A student who has completed the requirements for the Postgraduate Certificate in M ori and Indigenous Leadership with at least a B Grade Point Average across both courses, may apply to enrol in the Master of M ori and Indigenous Leadership and to transfer their courses to that degree.
- (b) A student who has not met the requirements of the Master of M ori and Indigenous Leadership, or who wishes to transfer, may apply to the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate for admission to the Postgraduate Certificate in M ori and Indigenous Leadership, the Postgraduate Diploma in M ori and Indigenous Leadership or the Master of M ori and Indigenous Leadership.
