

Profile


The drop down menu under Profile allows the user to create new user profile, select your dictation source (example: microphone, smartphone or digital recorder), add region based vocabulary to your profile, switch, open, close, backup, restore, save user profiles and exit Dragon. This option provides tools for writing into a DragonPad or Dictation box, transcribing text from outside sources like a digital recorder, adding a new command, viewing a list of commands for common programs, as well as formatting options. See figure below:




Vocabulary


